














USAGE PRECAUTIONS

Please read the warning and cautions carefully before using this appliance and comply strictly for your own safety and to prevent the damage that may occur on your property.

- The appliance is to be supplied through a residual current device(RCD) having a rated residual operating current not exceeding 30 mA.
- This appliance is considered to be suitable for use in countries having a warm damp equable climate. It may also be used in other countries.

WARNING

- Never push the switch cook when the inner pot with rice is not placed in, never insert any object into the switch. It may cause a trouble. 
- Do not immerse the set in water or sprinkling water on the heater plate and connector. 
- Do not use the cooker on a wet floor, under direct sunlight or near the gas stove. 
- While cooking, do not put the rice cooker on or near combustible materials such as curtains or vinyl carpets. 
- During or immediately after cooking, the areas near the steam vent hole are kept at high temperature. Do not touch those areas to avoid burns. 
- Never connect the plug with your wet hand as it may be dangerous from electric leakage. 
- Do not use any other inner pot except the provided one. 
- Children being supervised not to play the rice cooker and keep out of the children's reach, especially when cooking rice. 
- Never share the wall outlet with other appliances. 
- Do not opening the upper lid when during boiling because touched hot steam. 
- Do not disassemble or repair the cooker by yourself. It may cause trouble such as a fire of electric shock. Consult your nearest dealer. 
- The appliance is not to be used by persons (including children) with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge, unless they have been given supervision or instruction. 
- Do not touch the heating plate surface after use because of the residual heat. 
- This appliance is intended to be used in household and similar applications such as:
 - Staff kitchen areas in shops, offices and other working environments;
 - Farm houses;
 - By clients in hotels, motels and other residential type environments;
 - Bed and breakfast type environments.

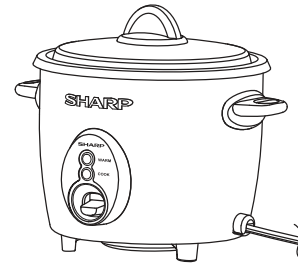
CAUTIONS

- Insert the plug into the wall outlet firmly and when disconnecting, hold the plug and pull it out without touching the power cord.
 - Do not use the damaged inner pot. It may cause in malfunction.
 - Do not use the inner pot with other heating appliances such as a gas stove. The inner pot may be transformed and it may cause poor cooking result.
 - Do not leave the plastic spoon in the rice cooker while cooking or warming.
 - In case the power cord is broken, it must be replaced by manufacturer or appointed service providers or equivalent professionals to avoid any damages. (Model : KSH-D06)
- In case the power cord is broken, it must be replaced with specialized power cord or the standard power cord made by manufacturer or appointed service providers. (Model : KSH-D11, KSH-D15, KSH-D18, KSH-D22, KSH-D28)

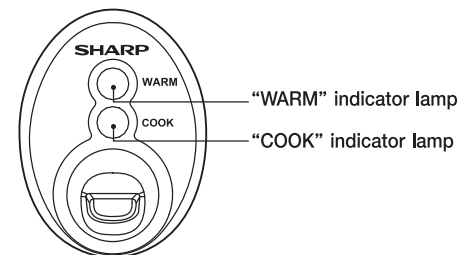
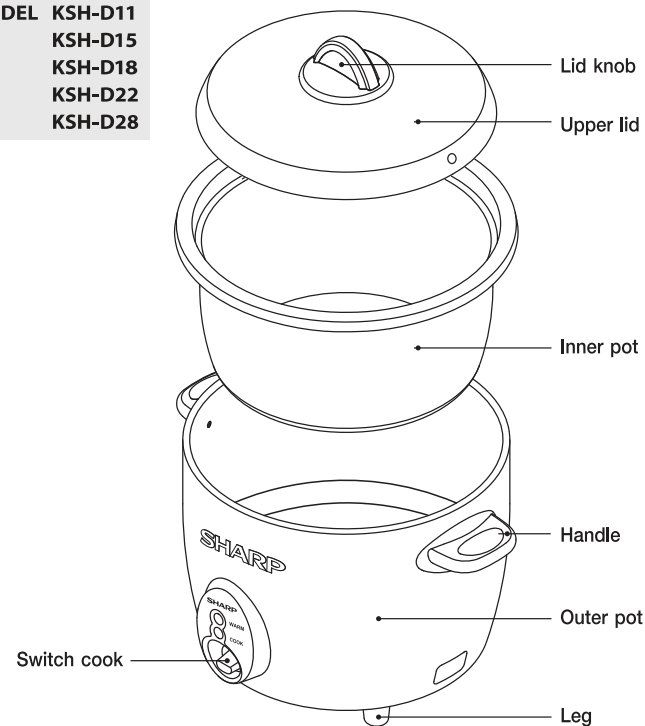

HOW TO USE

Be sure that the rated voltage is 220V only before use.

- Measure the volume of rice correctly. (The volume of the attached measuring cup is about 0.18ℓ or 180 cc.)

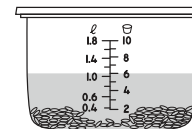


- Wash the rice in a separate bowl, put the rice into the inner pot and add water.

- Since the scale in the inner pot shows the standard water level, adjust the water volume according to your own choice.

Example (For 1.8ℓ)

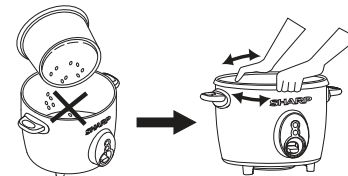
- To cook 6 cups rice, pour water to level of 6.



- Place the inner pot on the heater plate correctly by turning it slightly from left and right.

Caution

Before putting in, wipe off the moisture, dirt or rice grains on the outside of the inner pot or surface the heater plate.

- Close the lid firmly and insert the plug into the wall outlet. Press down on the switch cook.

Note

- When cooking is over, the "COOK" indicator lamp goes off and then the "WARM" indicator lamp lights on to start steaming. Keep on steaming without opening the upper lid for about 10-15 minutes for tastier and softer rice.

- After cooking is over and need to continue cooking, please wait for in order to allow about 10 minutes thermostat resume to normal condition.

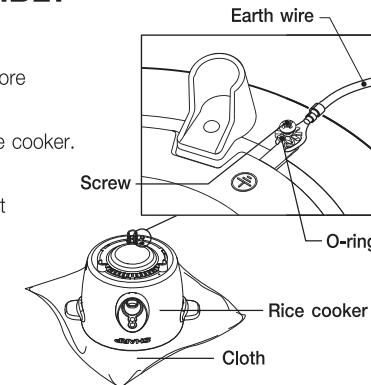
- Disconnect the plug from the wall outlet every time after use.

Warming method

- After complete cooking, the "WARM" indicator lamp keeps lighting automatically. The period of warming is approximately 4-5 hours. Longer warming may cause the cooked rice harden.
- If the cooked rice is cold and needs warming, unfasten the rice and sprinkle some water on the rice, push switch cook and wait until "COOK" indicator lamp goes off, then the "WARM" indicator lamp lights on. Keep on warming rice about 10-15 minutes before serving.

EARTH WIRE ASSEMBLY

- Disconnect power supply cord before assembly earth wire.
- Remove the inner pot from the rice cooker.
- Upside down the rice cooker.
- Remove screw for earth wire about 2-3 mm. (Symbol ⊕) and insert earth wire assembly and fasten screw for earth wire.



CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE

Always unplug and let the rice cooker cool down before cleaning.

HEATER PLATE ▶ Use the damp fine sandpaper to clean the dirty area and wipe out with sponge or damp cloth, then wipe again with the dry cloth to remove the humidity.

INNER POT/UPPER LID ▶ Soak inner pot and upper lid in lukewarm water and wash with sponge, washing detergent or liquid detergent and then wipe dry cloth.

OUTER POT ▶ Wash with sponge and wipe with cloth to dry it. Do not use any harsh cleanser or outer pot as it could crack the surface.
